PWD Boyle - reported projects completed for May were mulching Town Square, street sweeping, pool prep, set up and tear down for the 150th Parade, pot hole work on roads & alleys in the borough, dig trench for sign in Town Square, start curb painting, painted baby pool, routine build, street maintenance and sanitation pick up.

Projected jobs for June will be finish pool work and open pool, prep for fireworks and the 150th Celebration at Balliet Stadium, continue curb painting and trim trees at Parkway.

BCO Helman – Helman was absent, Bachman read report- 24 permits for the month of May 2019 amount received was \$1,700.00

Chief Genovese- 325 incident – 15 traffic arrests- 3 warnings and 53 parking tickets. Sodl stated that the quick tickets are being issued during patrolling. Police have issued 6 quick ticket warnings and all have been taken care of. Chief Genovese received a letter from A Buzz N Beyond requesting two thirty minute parking spaces to be placed in front of the barber shop located at 601 Chestnut Street. She is asking for the space since she does have a lot of older clientele who are not disabled but do have a difficult time getting around.

Chief Buskaritz – Reported that personnel participated in the Borough's 150th Anniversary parade, fire, police and personnel assisted Whitehall Fire Police at the Curt Simmons Day Parade, they will also have crews on standby for the 150th Fireworks Celebration on June 15th. Training for 3 personnel completed the 2nd Module of their firefighting courses and will be moving onto the next step shortly.

Bachman- Reported that the Girl Scouts of Eastern PA donated their key deposit for the pavilion back to the borough. Bachman and Benson did attend and complete a class for Municipal Budgets in May.
