Hearing of Persons Present – Anne Killeen asked if the Borough was aware of area campers under the bridges, and asked if there is a law to prevent them from camping wherever and whenever. Chief Emerich stated that there are several ownerships, and there would need to be a conservatorship established so that the borough would be able to patrol it for them.

PWD Boyle – Routine Streets work, Sanitation run and Building Maintenance. Mr. Boyle stated yard waste will start May 5th, Tire Drop off May 13th 9-2PM, Street Sweeping May 18-19th. Stadium lights are out on bid, Front & Keefer Truck Route project will be out on Bid on Friday. UGI will be starting to replace lines on Front Street, once completed it will move to 2nd Street.

BCO Helman –Month of February 2023- 41 permits with a total of \$3,875.00

Chief Emerich reported 222 Calls, 13 arrests, 17 Written Warnings, 8 Borough Tickets. Chief Emerich stated that DRC would have to install the Body Camera software, it will require a separate contract with DRC. Chief asked council to consider putting on agenda and approving to hire a cadet for the Police academy with provisions of the grant. Chief Emerich gave a shout out to Alex Mann “The Legend” he is an amazing young man who did a ride along with both Copley and North Catty, he speaks at colleges to help educate Police in how to handle situations involving Autism.
