Phil Armstrong- Lehigh County Executive

Mr. Armstrong has been selected to be on 2 national committees in the last few months. He spoke with the Director of Intergovernmental Affairs in the Whitehouse on a few issues. One of which was about the Rails to Trails section that goes to downtown Allentown completion. The other was about moving all Police departments from analog to digital radios. Each radio would cost between \$5,000.00 and \$6,000.00. This item was never brought to anyone's attention in the Whitehouse. Mr. Armstrong is already looking at a 5 year budget for the radios.

Burker said they are working on that. He did state that water and food would be allowed in the pool with the understanding that the people clean up after themselves, with no glass in the pool area.
